**TEWKESBURY ABBEY** is one of the finest medieval churches in England, consecrated in 1121, having a key part in 1471 during the Wars of the Roses, saved from destruction at the dissolution of the monasteries when the townsfolk of Tewkesbury saved the building by purchasing it for £453 from King Henry VIII, and extensively restored in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. The Abbey does not have the revenues of a cathedral and depends upon its visitors and friends from all over the world to help with its maintenance.

'The Friends' was formed in 1934 by the vicar at the time, Edward Pountney Gough. It makes an annual Fabric grant to Tewkesbury Abbey PCC, and in recent years has contributed significant sums to

- ◆ the upgrade to the lighting and sound systems
- ◆ the restoration of the Milton Organ
- ◆ the Abbey's 20.21 projects

The Friends hold an Annual Festival at the Abbey in July, and a number of social and educational events and visits throughout the year. The Friends have a very active Young Friends branch for under 18s.
